Seasonal Guide

Good Value

In Season at Source

Good value Roots - Value Veg lines - Carrots, Celeriac, Swede and English Beets are good value veg options by the case

Leek - decent value green

Citrus - Smaller lemons avail for

value - XL for best quality

Apples - For best value use

French Braeburn & Royal Gala

Local Asparagus – UK season and Cornish starting to be harvested now – cold nights slowing spear growth

Broad Bean & Peas - UK season is getting going Pear - some red forelle avail as an alternative to conference

Stone Fruit - European season starting - nice peaches and apricots starting to come in

Rhubarb - local outdoor now avail

Use with Caution

All Lettuce/Iceberg - Import prices remain extremely high due to issues in Spain and very low supply levels vs high Europe-wide demand. Possible complete market shortages

Melons – Between seasons – import volumes very limited and prices are right up – Avoid / Please check for best value when ordering

Berries – Local Strawberries now starting / Blueberries are good value / Raspberry eased a little but redcurrant market prices up & hard to find

Tomatoes/Cues/Broccoli/Courgette - Good news - prices are now easing across these ranges as harvest volumes increase and supply starts to balance against demand

Cabbage – Savoy now Spanish imports as local finished – prices reflect this / Red Cabbage now imported and prices up

Pineapples – Import prices have jumped up a little – portion control

Sugarsnap and Mangetout - Import prices are up - finebean best value out of the three exotic beans

Chicory - use white/yellow in place of red for best value

Red/Pink Grapefruit – price jumped up – use yellow for better value


