#### In Season at Source

Seville Oranges - Marmalade production time - get them while you can

Blood Oranges – now in and colour is good

January King - nice winter cabbage in stock & good value

Purple Sprouting - getting all we can based on harvests

Exotic Veg - Loose Finebeans are good value

Avocado - bulk value stock available - ripen in the kitchen - great value

Un-ripened Mango - good value option - shave into salads or ripen in kitchen

Sweet Potatoes - decent value boxes in stock Red Beetroot - Good Value winter veg line

Watercress - Dorset baby watercress avail in 200gm packs

Apples - English Cox, Bramley cookers, Gala and Russet available

Red and White Cabbage, Kales and Spring Green – best value options

for leafy greens / local and in season

Root Veg Value Nets available – 12kg Swede, 10kg Carrots, 10kg Parsnip and 10kg celeriac nets all in for roasts/function menus etc

Pear - English Comice Pear avail while stocks last

Winter Sprouts - in stock

Piccolo Parsnip – back in stock when available from growers

Banana Shallots - good value by the net

Citrus - Small lemons for best value / Seasonal leafy clems in stock when available in the markets

Devon Sprouting Beans and Alfalfa Seeds – good value and nutritious salad option

Lettuce – Imported crops now - gems twin pack and flat soft round lettuce are best value

Mushrooms - Forest Fungi local Devon mushrooms - fantastic range available to pre-order

### Use with Caution

Rhubarb - limited market availability so prices are high

Savoy and Pointed Cabbage -

moved to imports and price reflects this

Berries – out of season and all imported now and the market prices reflects this - strawberries particularly short in markets so prices right up as demand is high

Tomatoes - shortages at the markets post Christmas – all varieties are up in price – portion control recommended

Asparagus – imported prices remain high based on levels of demand – avoid if you can

Chicory - Red higher in price than yellow/white - use white if you can

Chipping Potato/Bakers -

saturated ground across growing regions means supply levels will be down going into 2024 and high demand will mean prices increases

Melons - Please check for best market value melons when ordering
